Wellness Education

Valley County Health System (VCHS) wants to help you stay healthy. An important component of maintaining your health is education and we will offer a variety of educational opportunities to help you learn more about your wellbeing. Physicians and other medical professionals will host many of these events to share their knowledge with members.

Pre-Hospitalization Registration

The 55PLUS application information helps expedite your registration process should you become an inpatient at VCHS. When you arrive at the hospital registration desk, be sure to show your 55PLUS card along with your insurance cards. We will need to copy them each time you register in order to file your insurance claims.

Guest Visit

Hospitalization can cause anxiety. If you become an inpatient, be sure to inform a staff member that you are a 55PLUS member. Feel free to request a visit from a 55PLUS representative to help answer any questions you may have about your stay. You can rest easier knowing a 55PLUS representative is there for you.

Guest Meal

Hospitalization of a loved-one can be a stressful time for family members. As a member, you will receive a free meal coupon for a family member so he or she can eat with you during your stay.

Insurance Filing Assistance

Insurance forms for medical bills can be confusing and time consuming. The employees of the VCHS business office will help answer any questions you may have about your insurance. Call 728-3211 for an appointment.

Serenity Spa Discount

Members will receive 25 percent off any spa treatment at Serenity spa located at VCHS. Treatments include massage, aromatherapy, exfoliation and hydration treatments. For an appointment, call 728-4247.

Notary Public Services

VCHS has a notary public on staff. As a 55PLUS member, free notary services are available to you. Call 728-3011 for an appointment.

Advance Directives

VCHS has staff that can discuss with you the importance of having a living will and durable power of attorney for medical care. VCHS encourages you to bring a copy of these documents to have on file with your medical information.

Free Blood Pressure Checks

A periodic blood pressure check is a good health practice to follow. The VCHS clinics in Ord, Burwell, North Loup, Ericson and Loup City offer free blood pressure readings. No appointment is necessary, simply check in with the receptionist when you arrive at the clinic.

Second Hand Rose Discount

The VCHS Auxiliary operates a thrift store in downtown Ord called the Second Hand Rose. Stop in and look around! Show your 55PLUS card and receive 10 percent off all regularly priced items. All proceeds will go toward the VCHS Auxiliary, which supports VCHS.
