About Us

Valley View Living Center is a licensed 60-bed nursing facility, providing high-quality care with compassion, dignity, and respect. As a service of Valley County Health System, professional nursing care is available to our residents 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Providing the care that is needed, we encourage residents to remain as independent as possible for as long as possible. Individualized programs are designed by our Restorative Care Department with consultation services available through the physical therapy/rehab department of Valley County Hospital. Many of our residents are short term as they recuperate following an accident or illness and soon return to their own homes.

Our Facility

Valley View Living Center is a comfortable, clean and attractive facility that residents can call home. They are encouraged, with their families, to decorate and arrange their rooms to reflect their own unique and personal style.

Residents can enjoy the company of family and friends in our spacious and beautiful atrium. Furnished with seating and tables, a large screen television, aviary, and kitchenette, we have all the comforts of home.

Healthcare

At Valley View Living Center, access to the physician, emergency care, and specialty services, such as lab and x-ray, is available daily. Valley County Health System provides the medical services you may need without the necessity of a long van ride to get there.

Staff members are trained in wound care, dementia care, rehabilitation and restorative cares, diabetes, and end of life care. A wound nurse is available on site and consults with staff and physicians to treat and prevent skin issues. Hospice care is also available on site.

Activities

Our Activities staff provides opportunities daily for residents to maintain a connection with the community, family, and friends by providing activities they can enjoy and participate in. Musical entertainment, pet therapy, bus rides, fishing outings, barbecues, religious activities, and holiday celebrations are just a few of the events available. Our many volunteers, with their time and talents, contribute regularly to our program.

Social Services

Social Services are available 7 days a week to assist residents with their social and emotional needs. Our Social Service designees strive to know each resident personally and encourage residents to set goals, make decisions, and continue to pursue the interests and activities they enjoy. They work closely with families and help everyone involved make the transition to long term care.

Meals

Independence is encouraged at meal time in our spacious dining room. We have delicious meals tailored to our resident's needs while allowing many choices at each meal. There is flexibility in dining times with a variety of snacks available throughout the day. A registered dietitian is on staff to meet the nutritional needs of each resident.

Special Care Unit

Valley View Living Center offers a Special Care Unit for the cognitively impaired person. We recognize the special needs of the resident and provide a quiet environment with increased staff involvement as needed for a secure and stable setting that promotes dignity and quality of life.

Transportation

Valley County Health System offers handicap accessible transportation to our residents for both medical and leisure activities. We encourage families to accompany residents for medical appointments. We also provide staff to assist residents to appointments when necessary.
